Preparation of solid proton conductors for intermediate temperature fuel cell

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The proton conductors, $\text{SiO}_2-\text{P}_2\text{O}_5-\text{TiO}_2-\text{PWA}$ and $\text{SiO}_2-\text{P}_2\text{O}_5-\text{TiO}_2-\text{imidazol}$ membrane, were prepared by sol-gel technique. Proton(H+) transport in solids has attracted much attention because of its potential use in clean energy fields, such as fuel cell, batteries and sensors. Tetraethoxysilane(TEOS), Trimethylphosphate(TMP), Titanium tetrabutoxide(TBOTi), Phosphotungstic acid(PWA) and imidazol were used as precusors of proton conducting membranes. The structural analysis of membranes have been studied by Fourier transform infrared spectroscopy (FTIR), X-ray diffractionl(XRD), differential thermal analysis (DTA) and thermal gravimetric analysis (TGA).
